- An Executive of parent volunteers in positions of Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.
- Committees that include Fundraising, Morning Snack Program, Communications and our Grant research and writing. We are always open to growth in volunteers, and welcome new faces with fresh ideas!

What do we do?

- The Executive complies with Governance and reports to Parents, Administration and the Division on a regular basis.
- Our Executive and Committees work together to plan Fundraising.
 - Gone are the days where parents and students fundraise only at the elementary level. You already have experience fundraising, and at NHS - many needs still exist, and government funding does not cover it all.
