### Planning Priority # 1

#### *Support School Community Partnership programs*

- Provide funding, sponsorship and donation coordination for Grade 9 Welcome, myBlueprint, Student and Staff Appreciation programs up to \$300 annually within budget.
- Provide funding and sponsorship for the purchase of a school BBQ, tank and tools for school and PAC use (\$500).

### Planning Priority #2
