Spectators at School Sporting Events

Effective today, November 1, HSD is permitting limited spectator access for <u>varsity</u> volleyball games with the following conditions:

- For each student-athlete, two spectators (fully vaccinated) are permitted to attend.
- Spectators must provide proof of vaccination and a corresponding piece of photo ID when they arrive at the school.
- Masks must be worn at all times while in the school.

NHS will continue to livestream all home games and spectator access will again be reviewed by HSD at the end of November.
