- Life/Work Exploration

Math Options:

Each math course has a different focus and intended student learning outcomes.

Applied/Pre-Calculus Focus

This course focuses on abstract concepts such as algebra, graphing, and data analysis. Students taking this course typically have a high interest and ability in mathematics.

Essential Focus

This course focuses on practical concepts and skills for daily living such as fractions, decimals, measurement, financial literacy, problem-solving and problem solving.

Humanities Options:

Most high school courses run for one semester (5 months). Students also have the option to do Grade 9 ELA and Grade 9 Social Studies as a combined class that runs for both semesters with the same teacher in both courses.
