Goal:

By June 2027, increase student and family engagement in school-wide activities by 25% through new initiatives such as community nights, mentorship/leadership programs, and collaborative student-led events.

Look Like:

- Regularly attended school events (assemblies, parent nights, cultural celebrations).
- Active participation in student leadership and volunteerism.
- Mentorship pairings between older and younger students.

Feel Like:

- Welcoming, inclusive, and connected.
- Students and families feel valued and part of a bigger purpose.
- Staff collaboration across departments.

Sound Like:

- "There's always something happening here that brings us together."

C – Culture

Goal:

By June 2026, implement and sustain a school-wide “Culture Code” with student and staff input that defines shared values, behaviors, and norms – measured by annual “climate” surveys showing 80%+ satisfaction.

Look Like:

- Posters and digital signage reflecting shared values (e.g. respect, empathy).
- Visible modeling of positive behavior by students and staff.
- Regular culture-building activities (e.g. shout-outs, peer recognition).

Feel Like:

- Safe, inclusive, and respectful.
- A place where students can be themselves.
 - Students are represented in the classroom
 - Students have ownership of what happens in the classroom
- Staff feel empowered to lead with values.

- “That’s not how we do things here.”
- “I appreciate how you showed respect.”
- “We take care of each other.”
